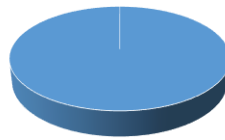

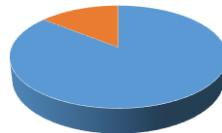

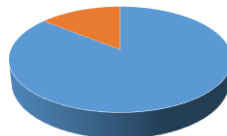
ACTIVITY OUTCOMES - How well did the activity do the following?

Enthuse and inspire pupils by involving them in practical STEM activities:



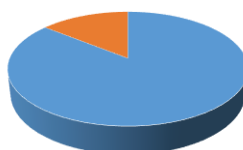

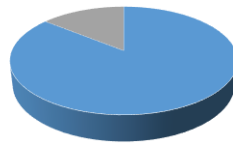

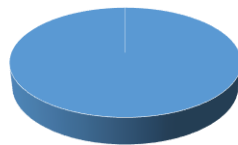
